

Sanitation in a Disaster

Sanitation is crucial in a disaster!

Sickness, Sevier Illness and even Death can result from Poor Sanitation

What to do? **Bucket Toilet**

Buy or Make a bucket toilet



- You will need a 5-gallon bucket
- Then buy a clip-on Toilet seat with a lid.

YOU CAN BUY A BUCKET AND LID SOLD TOGETHER

- Use it with garbage bags and kitty litter, sawdust, or shredded paper, etc. for absorbing and smell.

Dry Toilet

In an Emergency

you should make your toilet into a dry toilet

- Turn off the water to the toilet, flush the toilet, and dry it out completely. Remove water from the tank.
- Take a racquetball or lacrosse ball depending on the size of your toilet, and place it in a tube sock rubbed with grease or Crisco.
- Then push it into the toilet hole, *(the grease will act as a barrier against seeping water, and the long sock will make it easy to unplug when you are ready.)*
- Then line your toilet bowl under the seat with a plastic kitchen or trash sized garbage bag depending on the size of your toilet.
- You can use some kitty litter, sawdust, peat moss or even shredded paper to help absorb the liquid and help with the smell.*
